Your new Harrison Spinks mattress, divan and headboard is an investment and the first step towards creating your own unique sleep sanctuary.

Each piece is lovingly handmade to order using time-honoured techniques by our craftsmen and women in Yorkshire.

Please take the time to read these assembly instructions and care guide in order to understand which type of divan or headboard you have purchased and how to care for them.

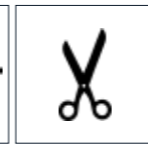
ON DELIVERY

Please read the instructions thoroughly before use to ensure safe and satisfactory operation. Locate the necessary tools and consult the fittings and parts checklist below before attempting to assemble your product.

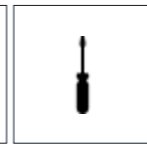
NECESSARY TOOLS



Two People



Sharp Pointed
Scissors



Flat Head
Screwdriver

This product is **HEAVY**, it should be unpackaged and assembled as near as possible to the point of use.

Always use two people to handle the product and take care when lifting to avoid personal injury and/or damage to the product.

DIVAN CHECKLIST

Divan Base: (assembly see page 4)

Single: 1 x divan piece, 1 x pack of castors/legs & headboard bolts, 1 x spanner.



Other Sizes: 2 x divan pieces, 2 x packs of castors/legs & headboard bolts, 1 x spanner.



HEADBOARD CHECKLIST

Full Depth Headboard:

Headboard, long headboard bolts x 4. (assembly see page 5)



Strutted Headboard:

Headboard, 1 x pack of screws & washers. (assembly see page 6)



If any components are missing please contact the retailer from where your product was purchased.

DIVAN ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



STEP 1

Turn both divan bases onto their side, lengthways with the centre clippings pointing upwards and remove the packs containing the castors or legs. Ensure the divans are in the correct orientation for the drawer configuration.



STEP 2

Whilst both divan bases are still on their side, screw in legs or castors using the spanner provided. Depending on the size of the product purchased, there could be four or more castors or legs to insert.



STEP 3

Flip both divan bases onto the castors or legs and fasten together using the interlocking clips. Don't worry if there is a small gap between the bases as this will come together under the weight of the mattress.



STEP 4

If you've purchased a divan with drawers, remove the transit drawer strap at this stage, by cutting the fabric in half with scissors. Gently pull the strap away at the top and bottom, taking care to remove any remaining staples.



DONE

You will have leftover headboard bolts that are only required if you have also purchased a strutted headboard.

ATTACHING YOUR FULL DEPTH HEADBOARD



STEP 1

Remove the pack of long bolts attached to the headboard. Use these instead of the small bolts in your divan pack.



STEP 2

Locate the ' Pierce here ' stickers. Consider carefully which end to pierce, particularly if your bed has storage that needs to be located in a specific position. **Only pierce the end you intend to attach the headboard to.** Using the stickers as guides, carefully pierce the fabric with a sharp-pointed implement.



STEP 3

Line the headboard up with the holes. Whilst one person holds the headboard upright, the other can start to screw the bolts into place.



STEP 4

Secure all bolts until tight to complete the assembly.



DONE

Your bed is now ready to position your mattress.

ATTACHING YOUR STRUTTED HEADBOARD



STEP 1

Remove the pack of screws and washers found at the bottom of the headboard.



STEP 2

Lay the headboard on its front and locate the pre-pierced holes. Adjust the struts (legs) so they point downwards, covering the pre-pierced holes. Using a screwdriver, screw the struts into place until tight.



STEP 3

Locate the 'pierce here' stickers. Consider carefully which end to pierce, particularly if your bed has storage that needs to be located in a specific position. **Only pierce the end you intend to attach the headboard to.** Using the stickers as guides, carefully pierce the fabric with a sharp-pointed implement then insert the bolts into the pre-drilled holes.



STEP 4

Lift the headboard above the bolts, aligning the struts (legs), then drop down on to the floor.



DONE

Once the mattress is in place, adjust the headboard to the correct height and secure the bolts until tight.

CARE & MAINTENANCE



GENERAL ADVICE

Keep all packaging, tools and fittings out of children's reach.

Do not allow children to jump on your divan, as this could damage the base.

Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.

Please consider the environment when disposing of packaging or products at end of life.



DIVAN STORAGE

If you have purchased a divan base with drawers, don't overload them with bulky or heavy items. Drawers have been designed to accommodate lightweight items only, such as pillows, bed linen or clothing.



CLEANING

Remove dust and fluff from your divan or headboard every few months using a soft brush. If upholstery gets marked from movement or use, marks may be removed by using a damp cloth and gently sponging the surface. If this is unsuccessful, appropriate upholstery cleaners may be used to remove the mark. Please contact the retailer from where your product was purchased for further advice.



MOVING

Furniture should be lifted and never dragged. Please take care when handling or moving the furniture, as careless handling may cause damage or injury. It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely disassembled and are moved by at least two people. Please be careful to retain all parts when doing this.
