

Oliver Bed - Assembly Instructions



Oliver Bed

Before you start

Thank you for purchasing this Oliver Bed.

Please read these instructions fully prior to assembly to familiarise yourself with the various stages of construction. Carefully open all packs supplied and check the contents against the parts and fitting checklist.

Do not destroy any of the packaging until you are certain that you have all the necessary parts for the assembly.

This item is heavy once assembled. Please try to assemble the item as close as possible to the point of use. Take care when moving the item to avoid personal injury or damage to the product and always lift rather than drag.

There are small components used in the construction of this furniture as well as plastic packaging, these should be kept away from young children whilst assembling.

Product Safety

All assembly fastenings should always be tightened properly, and care should be taken to ensure that no fitting are loose

Periodically check and ensure that all components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.

Product Care

To clean, slightly moisten cloth with water and wipe surfaces. A damp cloth holds dust and prevents damage. repeat with a dry, soft, lintfree cloth. Do not use abrasives or cleaning products which may contain ammonia or solvents.

Two people to assemble the product and two people to lift in to position.





Oliver Bed

1. Lay the Left Side Rail (C) on the floor taking care to ensure that it is upright with the bolt holes on both ends positioned as shown in the image. Slot both End Frame Sections (E) into the holes on the side rail. Slot both Mid Frame Sections (F) into the holes on the side rail, aligning the bars without plastic caps against the four bolt holes in the side rail. Use the Allen Key (K) to screw the Bolts (G) tightly.




2. Lay the Right Side Rail (D) on the floor taking care to ensure that it is upright with the bolt holes on both ends positioned as shown in the image. Slide the bars from the Frame Sections previously assembled into the holes on this side rail, aligning those without plastic caps against the four bolt holes in the side rail. Use the Allen Key (K) to screw the Bolts (G) tightly.

3. Your Oliver bed has two height settings depending on how high you want your mattress to be positioned. If you want the higher setting, then start by adding the Plastic Washer, Metal Washer, and Spring Washer onto the Bolt. Part screw the Bolts into the 2 middle holes on the Headboard and Footboard leaving 10mm protruding. Slot the Side Rails and Frame Section assembly onto these bolts using the hook at the end of the side rails, ensuring the washers are in the position shown in the diagram. Then screw bolts through the upper holes of the Side Rails as shown in the diagram and screw tightly into place using the Allen Key.

To fit in the lower setting follow the steps above but part screw the bolts into the 2 bottom holes on the Headboard and Footboard instead of the middle holes.



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
